# Read Through Luke in Lent

An old Lenten tradition invites people to give something up for Lent. It might be chocolate! It might be a favorite beverage. It might be giving up complaining, a good tradition always. The idea is you give something up you love for Lent as a reminder of how Jesus gave up His life for us. Most people who know about this tradition, know about the giving up part.

There's another aspect to the tradition, you give something up and then take something up. I'd suggest you take up reading through the Gospel of Luke over the next 40 days gives an opportunity to read, review and reflect on Jesus' life story. Luke covers the whole gamut of the story from Jesus' birth, teaching, miracles, death, resurrection and sending forth His disciples.

Over the next 40 days, you will have an opportunity to pursue 4 actions in this time in Lent.

**S- SCRIPTURE** – Read the verses for the day from the Gospel of Luke. Before you start reading pray, “Speak, Lord, Your servant is listening.”

**O – OBSERVE** – As you finish the reading, reflect on what you've just read. Each day consider these points and write down your answers: Think about who it was addressed to and why it was written. Ponder the meaning, tone, and purpose of what was written. Especially make sure to write down your observations.

**A – APPLICATION** – Personalize what you have read by asking yourself: How does this apply to my life right now? How will I put this into practice? How will I live differently?

**P – PRAYER** – Take time to pray each day. You can pray for anything at any time, but each day consider these three prayer questions: What do I want to thank God for? What do I need to ask forgiveness for? What do I need to ask God for?

Luke's account of the Good News of Jesus reminds us of the power of prayer and the Holy Spirit, and how Jesus came for all people. Each day you are invited to immerse yourself part of the story as together we read through Luke in Lent!

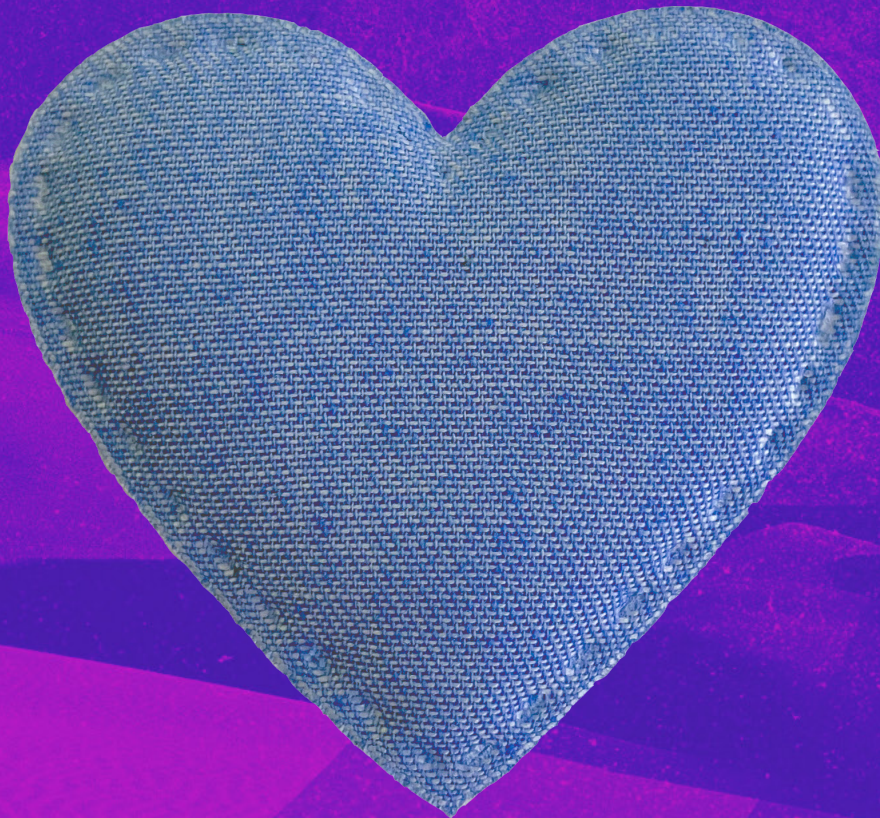

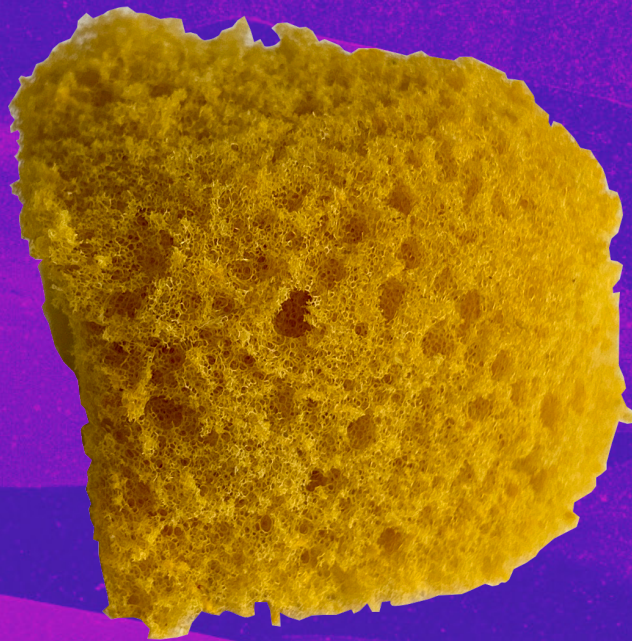
